

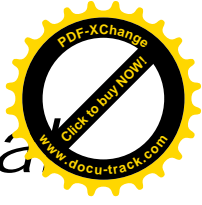
Blossom Festival Exhibit

Blossom Festival Fine Art Exhibit is a statewide art competition presented in conjunction with Canon City's annual Blossom Festival Parade and Music Competition. Thousands gather in Canon City for this much anticipated event. Purchases from former Blossom Festival Exhibits comprise much of the Fremont Center for the Arts significant permanent collection. Many art works are by Colorado artists, several of whom have gained national recognition over the years. The Permanent collection committee may recommend a "Purchase Award" of a piece they find desirable for the enhancement of the Permanent Collection. Any piece considered for purchase must be archival ready.

Judge - Fran Dodd

Fran Dodd's art education took place during four years of study at the Art Students' League in New York City, where she resided for most of her life. After being one of the first women artists elected to membership in the prestigious Salmagundi Club, the oldest professional artists' organization in America, she was invited to have a one person exhibit at that facility in 1981 and 1982. In 2005 she was inducted into the International Association of Pastel Societies "Masters Circle". Dodd has signature membership in Plein Air Artists of Colorado and Pastel Society of America. Her paintings have been juried into national exhibits throughout the United States, including The Pastel Society of America, National Association of Women Artists, Artists of Colorado, Degas Pastel Society, Pastel Society of the Southwest, Pastel Society of New Mexico and International Association of Pastel Societies. Fran Says, "I continue to grow as an artist. My learning and passion never ebbs. The destination is always before me and I never, ever "get there"!

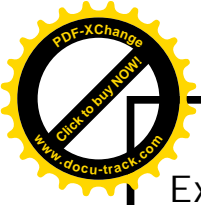

Any work previously exhibited at FCA juried or non-juried will not be accepted
All work must have been completed within the past 3 years

Submission of work for exhibition grants permission for photographing of work for publicity purposes and constitutes acceptance by artist for all conditions listed herein.

SALES

All sales will be conducted through the Fremont Center for the Arts Gift Shop.
 The Art Center will retain a 30% commission of the sale price.

PRESENTATION

All entries must be properly prepared for display. All works on paper must be under glass or plexi-glass and equipped with wire for hanging. No sawtooth, or clip and cord hangers will be accepted. Canvases should be stretched and equipped with wire for hanging. Small work must be wall-hung or pedestal locked display cases. Failure to comply will result in rejection of work. No fee refund.

All work must hang for the Duration of Show
