Judge Carlin Kielcheski

The judge selected for this year's Arkansas Valley Showcase is Carlin Kielcheski of Colorado Springs. Carlin is an art educator, native of Wisconsin, who came to Colorado with the Air Force in 1960. He served as professor of art at the Air Force Academy for twenty years, where he taught art appreciation, art history and studio to the cadets. A Vietnam veteran, he served as an Air Force Combat Artist there in 1968. A signature member and former president of the Pikes Peak Watercolor Society, Carlin is represented by galleries in Colorado, Wyoming and New Mexico. He has paintings in numerous private collections and has received awards for his watercolors in New York, Arizona, Wyoming and Colorado. Although Watercolor is Carlin's primary medium, he has exhibited works in oil, acrylic, graphics, woodcuts, etchings, and sculpture, (wood and bronze). He possesses a doctorate in art education from Arizona State University. Carlin likes best the perspective of children, "Art is something so beautiful inside that we want to get it out where we can see it"!

Welcome Artists

To the **Arkansas Valley Showcase**. This is a **non-juried** exhibit, in multiple categories. Open to artists of all skill levels to *showcase* their work and be judged by a qualified judge. **This is a non-juried show. Do not send slides or CD's. Application and fee is due by October 15, 2010. Date to deliver work is stated on Calendar.**

Eligibility

Entry is open to all levels of Colorado artists presenting **original works** in the listed categories. All art is accepted into this non-juried show. Work must have been created within the past **three** years, and **not** previously shown at the Fremont Center for the Arts or a juried or non juried show in Fremont County.

Reproductions are not accepted. FCA reserves the right to refuse any work not deemed appropriate.

Categories

Watercolor Oil/Acrylic Drawing
Photography Mixed media (inc. sculpture, fiber)

Awards

\$200 - 1st Place in each category.

\$100 - 2nd Place in each category.

- 3rd Place and Merit Awards will receive ribbons

Fees

- ⇒ FCA Members - \$15 for first entry, \$10 for each additional entry. Up to four entries per artist. (check or money order made payable to FCA)
- ⇒ Non Members- \$25 for first entry, \$15 for each additional entry. Up to four entries per artist. Fees are non-refundable.

Not a member of FCA? Become a member for just \$30 for an annual Individual Membership. Other levels are available as well.

Judging

Final selection of prizes and awards will be done by the Judge, in person after delivery of work to FCA. Number of merit awards given is at the discretion of the judge and in accordance to the size of the category.

Presentation

All works on paper must be under glass or plexi-glass and equipped with wire for hanging. **NO SAWTOOTH OR CLIP AND CORD HANGERS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Canvases should be stretched and equipped with wire for hanging. Small work must be wall-hung or pedestal ready or in display cases. Failure to comply will result in rejection of artwork.

Sales

All sales will be conducted through the Fremont Center for the Arts Gift Shop. The Art Center will retain a 30% commission of the purchase price.

Liability

We suggest artists carry their own insurance. All reasonable care will be taken with original art. The Fremont Center for the Arts will not be responsible for loss or damage, however caused. Catastrophic loss insurance does apply. Your signature on the exhibition entry form constitutes agreement with these terms and conditions.
