Eligibility

Entry is open to all Colorado artists presenting original works in the area of traditional and contemporary fiber art to include but not limited to: silk painting, silk fusion, wool felting, dying, painting stitching, dissolving, surface techniques and embellishment where fiber is the basis of the work. Non-traditional quilt art will be considered. Three-dimensional fiber art is acceptable. Size limits apply. Minimum size requirement is 16" x 20". Maximum should not exceed 60" on any one side. Work must have been created within the past two years.

Jurying

Selections will be made by slides and good quality digital media. Slides/pictures must be received with the entry form, fee, and legal SASE at the Fremont Center for the Arts (FCA). **NO LATER THAN April 18, 2008 at 4:00pm.** Please call FCA at 719-275-2790 if you have questions.

The Jury is comprised of professional artists and instructors in the field. The decision of the jury is final. Notification of accepted or declined pieces will be mailed by April 29, 2008.

NOTIFICATION AND SLIDES/PHOTOS OF NON-ACCEPTED WORK WILL ONLY BE RETURNED TO THE ARTIST IF ACCOMPANIED BY SASE WITH PROPER POSTAGE.

Slides & Digital Photos

Slides must be 35mm, 2"x2" mounted (no glass). Slides must bear the name of the artist, size of the work pictured, medium, and title as well as a clear notation of top, left and right sides of the work. Any slide not conforming to the referenced standards will be eliminated.

Digital Photos must be a minimum of 5 MP. Work must comprise the majority of the photo area and photo must be clear, crisp and of high quality.

Delivery of Artwork

Following notification of acceptance, work may arrive at FCA between May 29-31, 2008. Shipped works must arrive prepaid in a substantial, reusable container and must include payment for return shipping (including insurance). Shipped works must arrive by Fri. May 30, 2008. **Shipping address is Fremont Center for the Arts, 505 Macon Ave., Cañon City, CO 81212**

Return of Artwork

Following the close of the exhibition, entries for return shipment will be repacked in original container and shipped. Return shipments will be insured for the purchase list price unless otherwise noted. All hand delivered entries **must be picked up on Saturday July 12 between 3 - 5 pm or Tue. or Wed. July 15-16, 10am - 4pm**

Presentation

All entries must be properly prepared for display. **NO SAWTOOTH OR CLIP HANGERS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Any work mounted to canvases should be stretched and equipped with wire for hanging. Failure to comply may result in rejection of artwork.

Sales

All sales will be conducted through the Fremont Center for the Arts Gift Shop. The Art Center will retain a 30% commission of the purchase price.

Liability

We suggest artists carry their own insurance. All reasonable care will be taken with slides and original art. The Fremont Center for the Arts will not be responsible for loss or damage, however caused. Your signature on the exhibition entry form constitutes agreement with these terms and conditions.
